Since 2007, the EDP Awards—organised by the EDP Association—have recognised the best in digital technologies across digital printing, publishing, and converting.

This year, 25 awards will be presented on May 8th, 2025, covering main categories including Software, Large & Wide Format Printing, Commercial Printing, Packaging Printing, Specialty Printing, Finishing & Embellishment Solutions, Automation & Quality Control, and Inks & Substrates. The companies below have been recognized across the proposed EDP categories.

The EDP Awards 2025 reflect the latest technological advancements and trends in digital printing. As digital printing evolves, automation and software innovations are increasingly overshadowing hardware advancements. This shift is a natural progression within an industry in a digital transformation. Driven by AI, automation, and cloud-based services, software is becoming a key differentiator in print production.
